## MARCH 99

### MONTHLY SOCIETY MEETINGS

As from Monday 18<sup>th</sup> January 1999, the Fond du Sac Post Office began to operate in new accommodation in Dallas Building nearly opposite its former location.

### TEMPORARY CLOSURE - FOREST SIDE & GOODLANDS POST OFFICES

A Postal Services' Post Office Notice dated 1<sup>st</sup> March 1999 informed the public that Forest Side and Goodlands post offices had been "damaged by fire during the recent incidents which occurred in the country" and that postal services would not be available pending repairs to the buildings. At Forest Side a number of letters, incoming and outgoing, were burnt.

Civil disturbance (rioting and arson) broke out in Mauritius on Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> February 1999.

## NEW POST OFFICE - GRANDE MONTAGNE

A new post office at Grande Montagne in Rodrigues was inaugurated by the Honourable Minister for Rodrigues, Benoit Jolicoeur, on 22<sup>nd</sup> February 1999.

There are now five post offices in Rodrigues at Port Mathurin, La Ferme, Rivière Cocos, Grande Montagne..... and Mont Lubin which now operates from a building in Malabar where the sign on the building reads ..... Malabar Post Office.

## STAMPS

### Tricentenaire de la naissance de MAHÉ DE LA BOURDONNAIS 1699-1999

The Mauritius Postal Services released a single commemorative stamp on 11<sup>th</sup> February 1999 on the occasion of the "Tricentenaire de la naissance de MAHÉ DE LA BOURDONNAIS 1699-1999". The Rs 7 stamp on stamp adhesive features the reproduction of the 13<sup>th</sup> December 1899 ultramarine stamp (SG 136) against a purple background.

The official First Day Cover priced at Rs 25 and affixed with a single Rs 7 stamp (Rs 18.00 for the envelope) is illustrated with "an oil painting of La Bourdonnais by Lepaille" and carries, in the lower bottom right corner, the Tricentenary Logo.

Designed by the Crown Agents Stamp Bureau; printed by Cartor (France).

### Endemic Plants

On 10<sup>th</sup> March a commemorative set of four stamps titled "Endemic Plants" was put on sale. The four stamps feature flowers rather than plants.

- Re 1 *Cloredendrom laciniatum* (bois cabri)
- Rs 2 *Senecio lamarckianus* (bois chèvre)
- Rs 5 *Cyclindrocline commersonii*
- Rs 9 *Psiadia pollicina*

The official First Day Cover offered at Rs 25 (Rs 8.00 for the envelope) is illustrated with flowers of the gravely endangered endemic Rodriguan *Ramosmania rodriguessi* plant.

### 800B "1994" - WHERE IS IT?

Does the 800B Protection of the Environment 30 cents "1994" imprint date stamp exist?

In Stanley Gibbons catalogues mention is made of the stamp thus .....; "1994" Nos. 798B, 800B/1B, 804B; .....

We at the Mauritius Philatelic Society have never seen this stamp; we can confirm however the existence of 800B with imprint date "1995" which is (also) correctly mentioned in Stanley Gibbons catalogues.

Your editor and Sanjit Teelock discussed this issue and Sanjit wrote to Stanley Gibbons on 20<sup>th</sup> December 1998 offering to purchase an example of the 30 cents 800B with "1994" imprint date stamp..... the reply "We are out of stock. Sorry".

In March 1999 a UK based stamp dealer offered on page 21 of its MODERN BRITISH COMMONWEALTH STAMP sale the 800B as follows:"800B dated 1994 Mint £1. Used £1".

Sanjit faxed an offer on 22<sup>nd</sup> March 1999 for .... "800B 30c Imprint 1994 (not 1995) 10 copies mint and 3 copies used."

The dealer's undated reply reads:

"Many thanks for your fax - regret that we are unable to supply as we are out of stock - And the Crown Agents in London destroyed their stock on the 15<sup>th</sup> March".

Sanjit phoned the dealer to ask whether or not the dealer had actually seen any 800B 30c "1994" imprint stamp - the answer NO! Why offer something not to hand? - No answer.

Has anyone got an answer? Can anyone provide us with a 800B Protection of the Environment 30c "1994" imprint date stamp?
