## MONTHLY SOCIETY MEETINGS

**APRIL** - The April meeting was held on Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> April at 2 p.m. in the school hall of College St Esprit, Sir Virgil Naz Avenue, Quatre Bornes. J Adrien showed special covers signed by local dignitaries. S Ragoo showed British stamps of the Millennium, Royal Mail and Jersey Post Office. P Kwan showed specimen overprints, perforated specimen stamps of Mauritius and specimen postal stationery. M Antoine showed "Red Ink" - manuscript markings (crayon and pen) and date stamps, handstamps and franking marks struck in red.

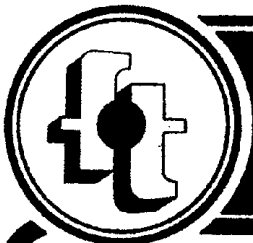
Attendance was poor, the Easter weekend may have been the reason; in Mauritius everybody goes off to the seaside at Easter.

**Mauritius Through Artists' Eyes**

On 18<sup>th</sup> June a commemorative set of stamps announced in press releases and in the Postal Services posters as "Mauritius Through Artists' Eyes" and on the official First Day Cover as "Mauritius Local Artists" was put on sale. The four stamps feature :

- Re 1 *Les lavandières* - Hervé Masson
- Rs 3 *Le casino* - Gaetan de Rosnay
- Rs 4 *Les quatre éléments* - André Poilly
- Rs 6 *Sortie de messe* - Xavier Le Juge de Segrais

The official First Day Cover offered at Rs 25 (Rs 11.00 for the envelope) is illustrated with *Le dodo bleu* by Malcolm de Chazal.

Stamp borders designed by Nick Shewring; printed by Joh Enschede, Holland.

The official 1999 stamp programme announced Poilly's stamp as 'Country side'.

## SPECIAL COMMEMORATIVE COVERS

EMTEL, the communications company that introduced the first cellular telephone service in Mauritius and the first commercial cellular phone service in the Southern Hemisphere on 29<sup>th</sup> May 1989 commemorated its 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary by issuing a special cover. The cover bears the 60 cents and the Rs 4 value of the "Post Office" 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary stamps of 1997 and the insert gives details of "a decade of innovations". A number of covers were offered to the Society. The cover is on sale at Emtel Customer Service Centre at Rs 25.00 each.

The MAURITIUS PHILATELIC SOCIETY prepared a limited number of covers on the occasion of the 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary stamp exhibition. The cover is datestamped on 11<sup>th</sup> June 1999, the day the Society's 10<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Expo was inaugurated at Max Boullé Art Gallery in Rose Hill. Franked with a Rs 5 Endemic Plant stamp, the cover is cacheted with the special Expo rubber handstamp.

## NEW SMART CARD

A new 55 units (Rs 50.00 + VAT) Mauritius Telecom Smart Card was put on sale as from May 1999. This card commemorates the 300<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the birth of François Mahé de La Bourdonnais and the issue is of 30,000 units.

## BANKNOTES

On 28<sup>th</sup> June the Governor of the Bank of Mauritius, Basant Roi, announced that six new banknotes would be introduced on 1<sup>st</sup> July 1999 to replace those put in circulation on 30<sup>th</sup> October 1998. In the main the order of Tamil and Hindi inscriptions are re-established, some colours have been changed and other improvements made. The Rs 1000.00 Gaëtan Duval banknote which has been redesigned, recto and verso, will be released later. Full details will be published in the next News Items in September 99.
