### MONTHLY SOCIETY MEETINGS

## POSTAGE STAMPS 1<sup>ST</sup> QUARTER 2001

The official postage stamp programme for the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter of 2001 is as follows:

January – Textile Industry - 4 stamps – Computer, Pull-over, Tee-shirt, Embroidery.

February – Abolition of Slavery and Termination of Indentured Labour - 1 stamp - Composition by local artists.

March – Natural History Trees - 4 stamps - Bois Puant, Bois d’Ebene, Manglier des Hauts, Bois d’Eponge.

The Slavery/Indentured Labour stamp is a political addition to mark a new public holiday as from year 2001 namely the Abolition of Slavery on 1<sup>st</sup> February; the Indentured Labour bit is inappropriate and is unrelated to the new public holiday as the date of this event (if it is to be commemorated ) is 2<sup>nd</sup> November.

On 9<sup>th</sup> October 2000 the “**Fishes of Mauritius**” definitive set of twelve stamps were issued as follows:

The stamps were designed by Andrew Robinson and printed by the House of Questa.

Three Official First Day Covers with four stamps per cover and another three Official First Day Covers each with a miniature sheet containing four stamps per cover are all illustrated with the same drawing. The official FDC cancellation cachet shows a Sea Horse.

Rs 9 Anjalay Coopen

Depicted in order are Chinese community leader, *Ti Frère* Creole “Le Roi Séga”. Moslem Medical doctor and Indo- Mauritian “Labour martyr”.

## TRANSFER OF POST OFFICES

### Petite Rivière

As from 16<sup>th</sup> October 2000 Petite Rivière Post Office began to operate in the renovated ex-village market building situated opposite the Police Station.

### Redit

As from 18<sup>th</sup> December 2000 Redit Post Office began to operate from a newly constructed building situated almost opposite the building it previously occupied. The old Redit Post Office occupied the whole of the small building which was once the Governor of Mauritius private railway station.

## WORLD POST DAY

On the occasion of World Post Day on 9<sup>th</sup> October 2000 an exhibition of stamps was held at the Postal Museum and at the General Post Office in Port Louis from 5<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> October excluding Sunday 8<sup>th</sup>.

World Post Day rubber stamps were used from Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> October to Monday 9<sup>th</sup> October at several post offices.

The “**Fishes of Mauritius**” definitive set of postage stamps was issued on 9<sup>th</sup> October, World Post Day.

## DEFINITIVE ON ENVIRONMENT

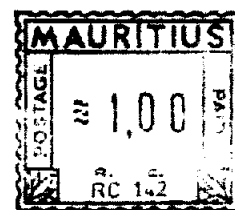
From Circular Instruction No. 30/2000 reference PS/FD/952 dated 29<sup>th</sup> September 2000.

Item 5. “ All unsold postage stamps of the current definitive on Environment should be returned to Headquarters as a remittance to the Postmaster General by first available mail on Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> October. These stamps will still be available at the Philatelic Bureau and Postal Museum only.”

## METER MARK – ILE MAURICE

A new meter mark struck in red reading “671 PORT LOUIS ILE MAURICE” from B.C.M. (Secretaries) Ltd of Chaussée, Port Louis is the first such meter mark using the French Ile Maurice instead of the traditional Mauritius. Earliest date seen is 31.7.00; anyone know of an earlier date?



The stamps were designed by Ray Hutchins and printed by the House of Questa..

The Official First Day Cover is illustrated with a composite drawing incorporating an Abacus, a *Ravane*, a Stethoscope and a Sickle described as “the tools and instruments associated with the personalities”. The musical instrument associated with *Ti Frère* is the “*triangle*” and not the “*ravane*”.

Note: the spelling of the names Affan and Goumany on the stamps and the missing dates on the Rs 9 stamp.

### TELECOM SMART CARDS

A new Smart Card featuring the 15<sup>th</sup> Century Portuguese vessel “Sao Gabriel” and a map to mark the “500<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the discovery of Mauritius” was put on sale in October. The card is of 115 units, bears the date August 2000 and is an issue of 30,000 units.
