Dear Member,

The Society realises that during the last two years our Overseas members have had to rely on the Newsletters for news on the activities of the Society.

January 1992 Meeting: 11th January 2 p.m.

REPUBLIC OF MAURITIUS

On 12th March 1992 a set of four stamps titled "Republic of Mauritius" was released.

The stamps featured:-

- 40c. The President and his official residence Réduit.
- R4. The Prime Minister and Government House, Port-Louis.
- R8. A group of "Arc-en-Ciel" children looking "enthusiastically" at a gaudy rainbow.
- R10. The Presidential "Flag".

The official first day cover was illustrated with the Trochetia Boutoniana - the official flower of Mauritius.

On 12th March 1992, a public holiday, 19 post-offices were opened exceptionally from 8 a.m. to Noon for:

- (a) the sale of first day covers
- (b) the sale of stamps
- (c) the registration of letters

No other services were offered on the 12th March 1992.

Animal World Philatelic & Numismatic Exhibition

at JALAH SHUJA HUMANE EDUCATION CENTRE - Rose-Hill

20th to 29th March 1992

A special rubber hand-stamp with the above wording was used at Rose Hill post office to commemorate an exhibition staged at Rose Hill by the Mauritius Society for Prevention of Cruelty to Animals.

This exhibition, the brain-child of Dr Shuja, was arranged by Mico Antoine with the assistance of Jean Dequaire, Diane Sher Khan and Seesambah Ragoon.

Non-philatelic items such as coins and bank notes were provided by Dr Shuja and his colleagues.

All the material on display (stamps, covers, post cards, illustrations, coins, bank notes) featured (as complete as possible) aspects of the Animal World.

The range of specimen shown included dinosaurs, big game; domestic pets, reptiles, insects, marine life, extinct and endangered species, etc.

The exhibition which had very wide media coverage was officially inaugurated by the Prime Minister of Mauritius the Right Honourable Sir Aneerood Jugnauth on the evening of 19th February 1992.

The Mauritius Philatelic Society on T.V. and Radio

On 23rd February the M.S.P.C.A. exhibition was featured on the television programme "Bonjour Bon Dimanche". Mico Antoine did the commentary on the stamps shown during the programme.

On 8th March Yvan Martial and Mico Antoine appeared on the programme "Bonjour Bon Dimanche". Yvan Martial narrated the "History of Mauritius on Stamps" on stamps issued from 1968 to 1991. This programme was part of the build-up leading to the accession of Mauritius

to the status of Republic on 12th March 1992.

On 21st March Jacques Maunick's programme "Contact Inter-îles Océan Indien" was aired on Mauritius Broadcasting Corporation radio services. The programme was based on an interview which Jacques Maunick had with Mico Antoine, and the programme was also aired on the radio services of Francophone islands of the Indian Ocean.

JUNE 1992 STAMP EXHIBITION

The 2nd Society Stamp Exhibition is scheduled to be held from 19th June to 27th June at Max Boullé Gallery, Rose Hill.

Preparations are progressing satisfactorily. Contact with Overseas members have been fruitful and two members, Rick Millar of Rhode Island (U.S.A.) and Jim Drummond of Bucks (U.K.) have so far provided material for display. The active participation of local members is assured. This exhibition will therefore have the active participation of both Local and Overseas members and that is a very welcome development.

The theme this year is "The Sea - La Mer".
